First Love Ministries USA (FLMUSA) Benevolence Criteria

FLMUSA, as a Christian ministry focused on reaching out to share the Good News of Jesus Christ, will from time to time become aware of certain unique situations that might require a response in the form of limited and measured financial help.

As such, and during the normal process of Christian ministry activities conducted by the various members of the Board of Directors of FLMUSA, certain individuals who call upon the name of Jesus Christ may be identified as having an extreme personal need for financial assistance.

When such an individual is identified the details of their need and circumstances are brought to the attention of the Benevolence Screening Committee by one or more members of the Board of Directors. One or more of the members of the Benevolence Screening Committee will review all available information and personally interview the individual candidate to determine if their need meets the four main criteria as established by the Board of Directors:

- 1.) Has the particular need been investigated and verified through reasonable investigation of one or more of the Board members?
- 2.) Does the individual have other reasonable means at their disposal to meet the need?
- 3.) If FLMUSA helps the individual would it be a Christ glorifying endeavor?
- 4.) Does FLMUSA have sufficient reserves to fund the need when taking into consideration the other ministry needs being served by FLMUSA?

After the information is collected and reviewed using the above criteria a determination is made and the request is either approved or rejected.

If the request is approved an approval form will be created and signed by a member of the Benevolence Screening Committee.
